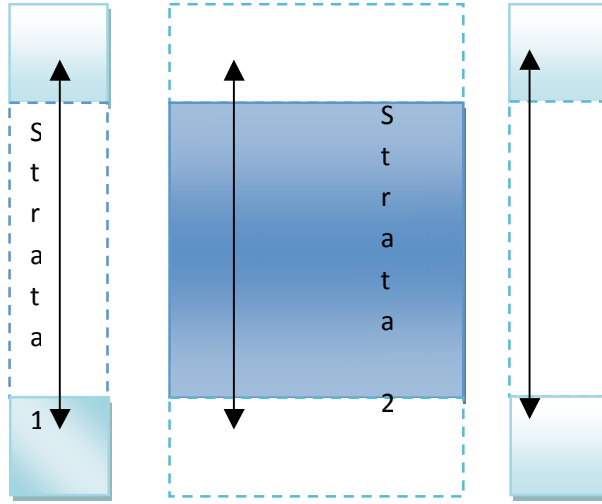
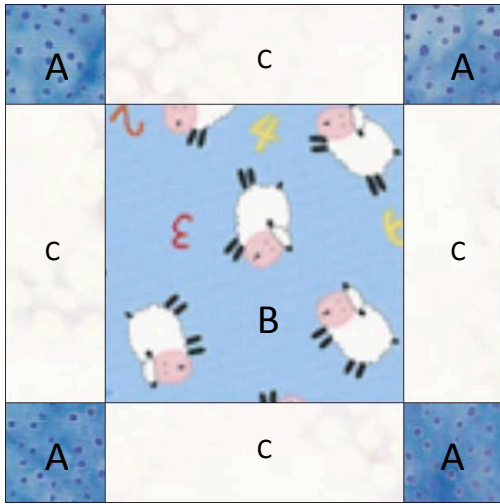


Nine Patch Challenge for October

block is 10 1/2" square - 10" (once you've sewn it into a quilt)



Baby Boy Blue

Colours – Blue
& White

A) Blue – Cut 4 – 2 1/2" squares

B) Blue (or focal fabric, mainly blue) – Cut 1 – 6 1/2" square

C) White – Cut 4 – 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles

*** If you're stitching more than 1 block you might want to consider cutting strips of fabric and creating stratas.

Strata 1 – Cut 2 strips (wof x 2 1/2") of blue and stitch to 1 strip (wof x 6 1/2") of white. Press towards dark colour. Once pressed, cut 2 stratas for each block that are 2 1/2" wide.

Strata 2 – Cut 1 strip (wof x 6 1/2") of blue (focus blue fabric) and stitch in between 2 strips (wof x 2 1/2"). Press towards dark colour. Once pressed, cut 1 strata that is 6 1/2" wide.

Stitch Strat 1 to both sides of Strata 2. Press seams towards centre. Make as many blocks as you need.

(wof = width of fabric)
