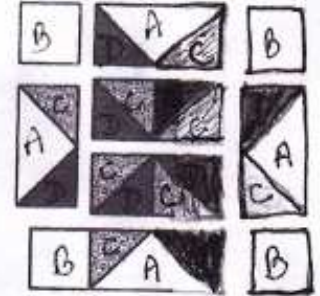
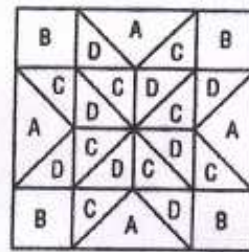
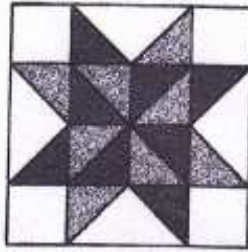


Block of the Month – January

Sarah's Choice



FOR 1 BLOCK

Light	A:	1		→		5 1/4"
	B:	4				2 1/2"
MEDIUM	C:	4		→		2 7/8"
DARK	D:	4		→		2 7/8"



This is a lovely simple star block for a new year. Try it with some nice bright colors and/or a black and white block.

Cutting instructions:

Cut 1 - 5 1/4" "A" block and then cut diagonally from corner to corner and again diagonally from corner to corner giving you four triangles.

Cut 4 - 2 1/2" squares for the "B" block. The "A" & "B" blocks are light colors.

Cut 4 - 2 7/8" squares for the "C" block and cut diagonally from corner to corner to give you eight triangles. These are medium colors.

Cut 4 - 2 7/8" squares for the "D" block and cut diagonally from corner to corner to give you eight triangles. These are the dark colors.

Sewing instructions:

Following the picture, sew a "D" & "C" triangle to an "A" triangle to make 4 rectangles.

Sew the "B" squares to two of the "DAC" rectangles.

Sew the remaining "C" & "D" triangles together.

Sew the "C" & "D" squares together to make the middle square and add remaining "DAC" rectangles to each side of the "CD" square.

You now have three rows which can be sewn together as shown in the picture.
