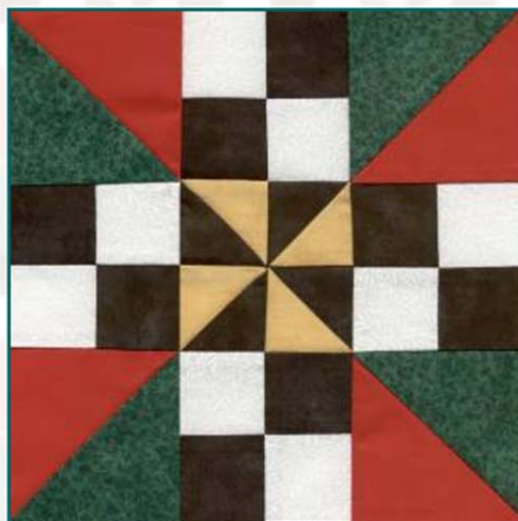

9" x 9" block  
(9½" unfinished)



### FABRICS:

Use solid colours, or tone-on-tones that read as solids

|            |   |
|------------|---|
| One<br>One | 18" x 2" strip Black<br>18" x 2" strip White<br><br>Sew Black and White strips together, press seams toward Black, and cut into eight 2" sections.<br>Sew these together in pairs to make four 4-patches.   |
| Two<br>Two | 2 3/8" squares Black ) Cut in half<br>2 3/8" squares Yellow ) diagonally<br><br>With right sides together, sew each Black triangle to a Yellow triangle, making half-square triangles for centre.<br>Press seams towards Black. Trim points.              |
| Four       | 3 7/8" squares assorted colours - Red, Blue, Green, Purple, or Orange - use bright clear colours.<br><br>With right sides together, sew these triangles together to make the four corners of the block. Trim points.<br><br>Assemble block as shown here. |
