# Summer Spinner

8" X 8" Finished Block - 81/2 X 81/2 unfinished


#### **Fabric Requirements:**

You will need six fabrics.

- 4 light pastel fabrics A,B,C,D
- 1 dark fabric for back of pinwheel E
- 1 tone-on-tone light beige background fabric F

Step #1: Create 4 - 21/2" drunkard path blocks - each with the same dark fabric for back of pinwheel (21/2" Square) colour (E) and one each of your four light pastel fabrics (A, B, C, & D) for the 1/4 circle of your drunkard path. I found that hand appliquéing the arc block onto the square was the simplest for me since the arch uses up most of the background block.


**Step #2:** Create 4 Half-Quarter-Square Triangle Blocks - one each with the 4 pastel fabrics (A, B, C, & D) and the same light beige background fabric (F). You can use your own method of construction for this block. The unfinished size required is 2½" x 2½" Square.




Step #4: Join each drunkard's path block with the same colour half square triangle to form a propeller shape. See diagram #1

Step #5: Join each propeller shape block with one 21/2" X 4½" background beige rectangle as indicated in diagram #2.

You should now have 4 - 41/2" square blocks - each with a different propeller blade colour but all with the same colour (E) background behind your 1/4 circle drunkard's path block.







Step #6: Assemble the 4 - 41/2" squares to create the finished block using the layout diagram at the top of

the page.
