

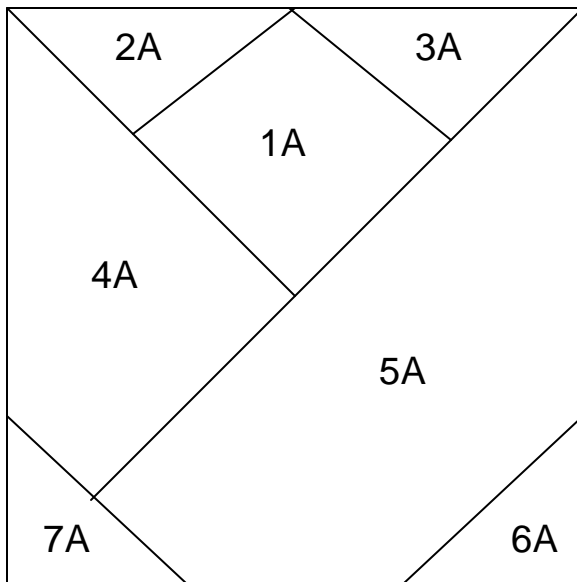
# FVQG February 2007 Block of the Month

## Tulip Time - Thinking Spring

4 1/2" x 10" Unfinished - 4" x 10" Finished



Top Piece - A



### Fabrics Required:

**Background:** White (tone on tone or lacquer print)

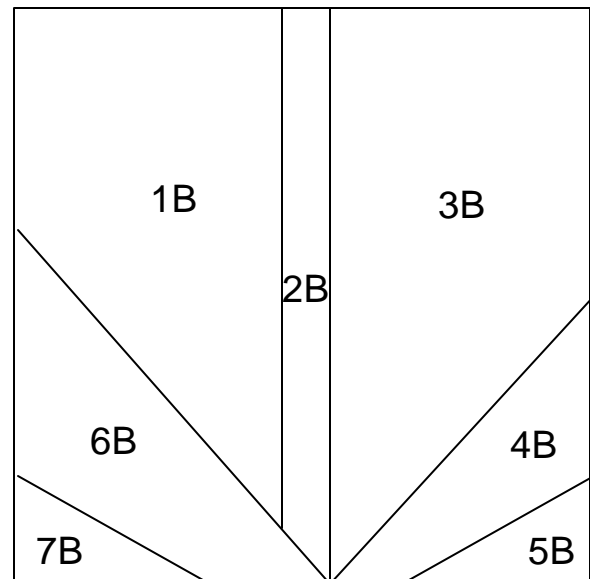
Pieces 2A, 3A, 6A, 7A, 1B, 3B, 5B, 7B, 2C & 3C and 1" strips for outside border.

**Tulip:** Your choice of tulip colours - make 1A a contrast colour to your tulip choice for 4A & 5A

**Stem & Leaves:** Green for 2B, 4B & 6B

**Flower Pot:** Bright Fun Print for 1C and contrast for 4C

Middle Piece - B



Create your paper-pieced tulip using your favourite paper-piecing method. If you aren't familiar with paper piecing here are a couple of good web pages which give detailed instructions:

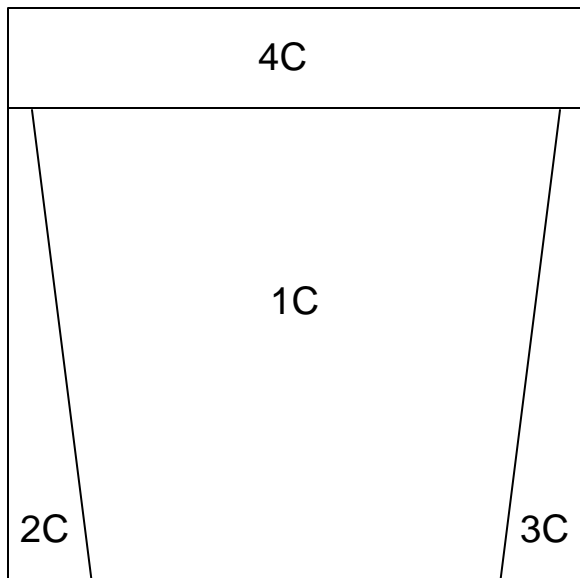

Bottom Piece - C



### Finishing:

Join all three sections together to form your tulip in the pot. Please leave all of your papers on your completed tulip block. Add a 1" border to each side and then the top and bottom. This will bring your block up to the **unfinished** size of 4 1/2" X 10 1/2".



Did you have fun making this tulip? Look for a 2nd Tulip Top pattern in the newsletter . . . Use the same stem, leaves and flower pot to create a 2nd block.
