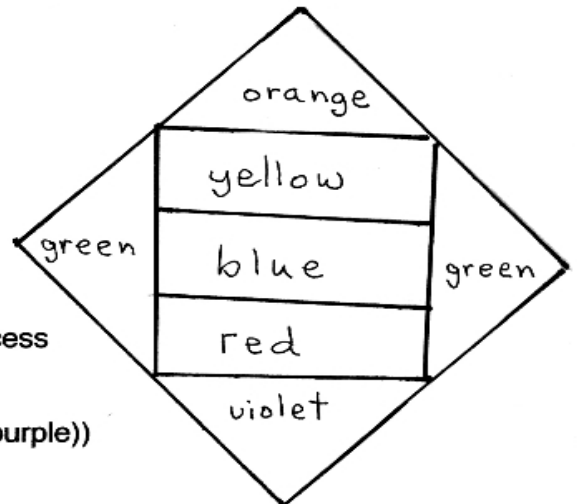
SCHOOL COLOURS (a homework exercise using the colour wheel)

- finished block size $8\frac{1}{2} \times 8\frac{1}{2}$ inches
- unfinished block size 9×9 inches

Fabric Requirements:

- 6 solid or print fabrics where the background colour is dominant. Choose clear, pure hues as close to those on the colour wheel as possible. Try not to use greyed tones. (When we were making up the block it was harder than we thought to find these kinds of colours in our stashes. Enjoy recess with your stash.)


- 3 Primary colours (red, yellow, blue)
- 3 Secondary colours (green, orange, violet (purple))



Step 1. Primary Colour Centre Block: $6\frac{1}{2} \times 6\frac{1}{2}$

- Cut 1 strip $6\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ of each primary colour
- Sew strips together using $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams with the blue strip in the middle.
- Press seams towards centre strip.

Step 2. Green

- Cut out 1 $5\frac{1}{4}$ " square.
- Cut square in half diagonally to make 2 triangles. 
- Sew the long edge of the triangles to the multi-coloured ends of the centre square. (to centre the triangle before sewing, line up the triangle point with the centre of the blue strip.)
- Press seams towards the green triangles.

Step 3. Orange and Violet

- Cut one triangle of each using the template.
- Sew the orange triangle onto the yellow end of the square.
- Sew the violet triangle onto the red end of the square.
- Press seams towards the triangles.
