

Geese flying through the Maple Leaf Star -- June BOM



Fabric---Red
Darker Red
White

Cut 10 white rectangles $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$
4 white squares $2\frac{1}{2}''$

Cut 8 red squares $2\frac{1}{2}''$
2 red rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 8\frac{1}{2}''$
2 red rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$
4 dark red squares $2\frac{1}{2}''$

Please use a scant $\frac{1}{4}''$ seam

To make flying geese place a $2\frac{1}{2}''$ square of darker red fabric on top of white rectangle. Right sides together. Mark a diagonal line across your red square. Sew on diagonal line. Press open, trim. Do the same at the other side.

Do the other flying geese the same way. In all a total of 6 flying geese. Sew 2 darker red flying geese together. Add a red $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$ to one side of flying geese, then add the other red rectangle to the other side. Add a red flying geese to one side and another to the other side. Add 1 - $2\frac{1}{2}''$ square to one side of red $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 8\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangle doing the same at the other side. Lastly add a white $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangle to a red flying geese and add another rectangle to the other side. Unfinished Block is $12\frac{1}{2}''$.
