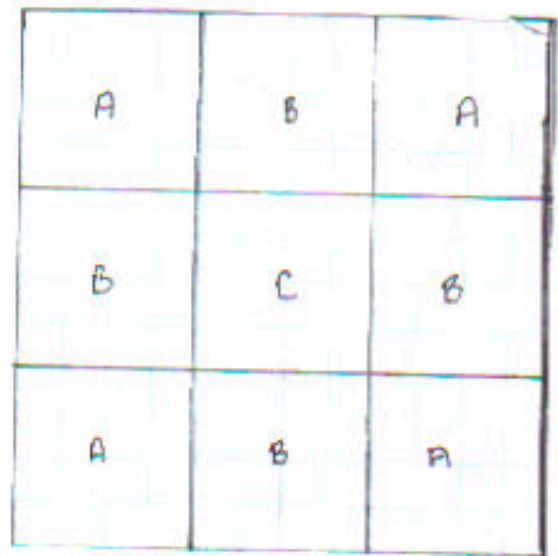
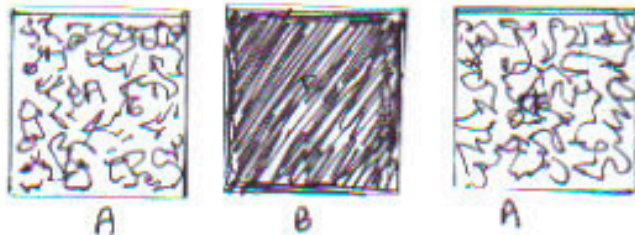


BOM for September 9-patch revisited



The BOM is a standard 9 patch made up of 4" squares. The colour theme will be cream with various red-mauves. My feature fabric is a cream back ground with purple & mauve floral print. The other squares match the purple & mauves of the feature fabric. Fat quarters work well for this project.

Cut

- A. Feature fabric: cut 4 – 4" squares
- B. Mid value of mauve (leaning toward red-mauve): cut 4 - 4" squares
- C. Centre accent dark value purple: cut 1 – 4" square

After you have cut your fabric, line up the 4" squares as indicated on the diagram.

Sew the top row A to B and B to A...press so the seams go to the dark.
Continue with row two....B to C and C to B. Press seams toward B.
Row three is the same as top row.

Press seams and the block is complete....for the meeting but still more surprises to come when we revisit the Nine-Patch.

At the meeting you will see how this simple nine patch can create a Greek Key border or an interesting pattern with the re-cut nine patches.
