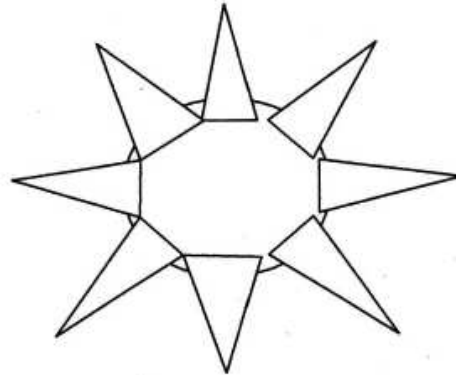
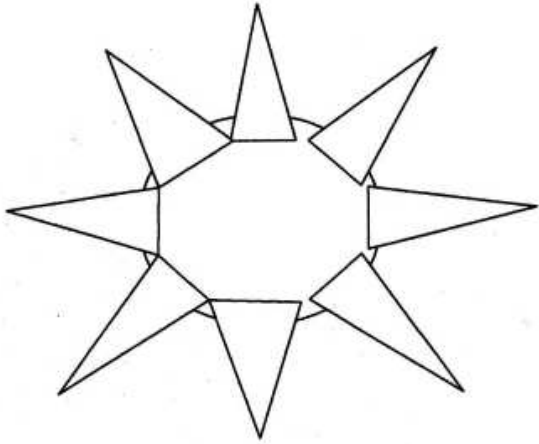
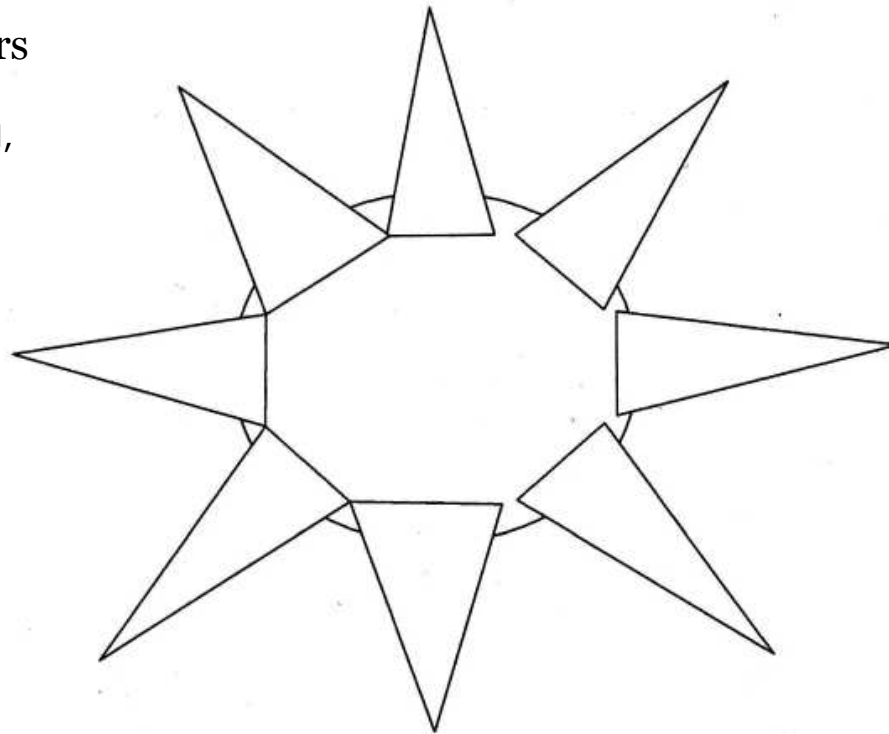


Block of the Month – November



Twinkling Stars

8 1/2" unfinished,
8" finished



These stars for November can be hand, machine, or raw edge appliquéd.

Making paper templates for the points & circles would make this block easier to put together.

Trace each piece on the non shiny side of freezer paper. You can then iron the freezer paper to the right side of the fabric which you are using for the points and circles.

Add a 1/4" seam allowance if you are going to hand appliquéd, or cut right to the edge of the paper if you going to machine applique.

The background could be a light coloured print that reads as a plain fabric.

We would suggest that you sew the points of the stars first, then sew the centers of the stars on. They can be placed randomly on the background fabric.

You can make your stars as bright and lively as you like: think Kaffe Fassett colors. You can do a black and white one as well. A black background with white stars would look great.
