

Rosebud 12 ½ unfinished

Fabric Requirements

White Background – four – 3 ½" by 6 ½" rectangles

Two – 5" squares

Four- 3" squares

Green - Two 5" squares

Bud (colour is your choice) – Four – 3" squares

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of all the background squares (the 3 inch and the 5 inch). Pair the four coloured squares (bud) with the four white background squares right sides together. Sew ¼ inch on either side of the diagonal line. Cut on the drawn line. Press and trim your squares to 2 ½ inches. You will have 8 of these. Pair the green 5" squares with the white 5" squares right sides together. Again, sew on either side of the drawn line, then cut on the line, press and trim to 4 ½ inches. You will have four of these.

This block is made in four sections. Each quadrant is made separately and then the four are put together like a four patch.

First sew the 8 bud squares together in pairs. Use the picture to make sure you have the points going the right direction.

Take one of your pairs of buds and sew it to one of the white and green squares, again check the picture. Now sew one of the white rectangles onto the side. This completes one quadrant. Make the other three quadrants, then sew the four together like a four patch.
