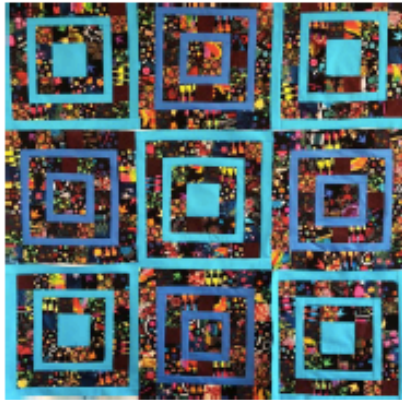


Block of the Month

April BOTM - Black and Blue Square in a square

Completed block size is 16.5"



This month for a change [and a gamble], I have decided to do this two block quilt. It's a gamble because approximately the same number of the two blocks need to come in to make it work. Maybe you could consider to do one of each, but leave lots of time to do, it as it is not quick.

I was looking around in my Fabric Library and noticed that I had a couple of these black background with bright pattern fabrics. I searched through my black fabric bin, my kids fabric bin, the Christmas fabric bin, the Japanese and the Aussie fabric bins and found about 15 different prints that would work. You might also check some of your charm pack

bundles and ask some friends if they have some of the fabric. Don't use solely black and white fabrics for this version.

Be very accurate in your cutting and sewing of a scant 1/4" seam.

BLOCK 1



Fabric requirements:

2.5" black pattern squares – 48 [try to use at least 6 different prints]

Sew a four square

Sew 2 sets each of 3, 5, 6 and 8 squares in a row

1.5 wide solid bright blue strips

2 each of 4.5", 6.5", 10.5", 12.5"

Instructions: [they are pretty simple]



Take the four square [measuring 4.5" square].



Add on the 4.5" then the 6.5" solid blue strips.

Add each of the 3 square sets to opposite sides; then add the 5 square sets.



Continue by adding the 10.5" then the 12.5" solid blue strips.

For the final round add the 6 square sets then the 8 square sets. You're finished.

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BLOCK 2



Fabric requirements:

black pattern squares – 2.5" x 36 [use at least 6 different prints]

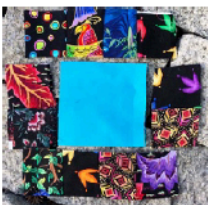
Sew 2 sets each of 2, 4, 5 and 7 squares in a row

bright blue solids

4.5" square for centre

1.5" strips - 2 each of 8.5", 10.5", 14.5", 16.5"

Instructions: [they are pretty simple]



Take the 4.5" centre square and add a set of 2 square to each side. Add the 4 square sets to the other sides.



Add the 8.5" strips to opposite sides, then the 10.5" strips.

Continue adding the black squares then finishing with the blue strips to measure 16.5".
