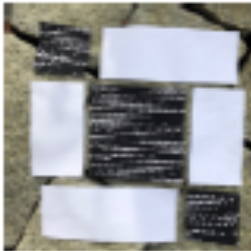

May BOTM – Rain Chain

The simplest block looks amazing if you just put it on point. This version reminded me of the rain chains that you see in garden centres. You can just imagine water pouring down the chains. As I said, this is a very simple block, but some quick instructions are listed below.

Materials:

Black and white

1 - 4.5" x 4.5"

2 - 2.5" x 2.5"

Note: There should be more black with white blocks but if you are thinking of making a couple, then add an additional white with black. For the colour blocks, I think the winner might choose which colour she prefers. The extra colour does help with some definition.

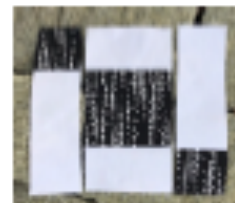
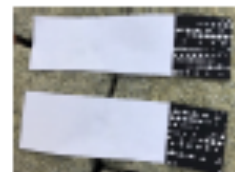
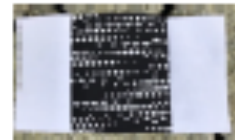
Solid white

2 - 2.5" x 4.5"

2 - 2.5" x 6.5"

Instructions:

1. Sew each of the 2.5" x 4.5" white strips to opposite sides of the 4.5" b&w square block.
2. Sew the 2.5" b&w square blocks to the ends of the 2.5" x 4.5" white strips.
3. Sew these strips to opposite sides making sure that the small b&w squares are at opposite ends.



It's that simple.
