## APRIL - TEACUPS

Block Size: 6 1/2" unfinished - 6" finished

Fabric requirements: Pale blue background Any colour you wish to use for the teacups

#### Cut: Pale blue background

B - two - 1 1/4" squares

D - one - 1 1/4" square

F - one - 1 5/8" x 1 1/4"

G - one - 4 5/8" x 1 5/8"

H - one - 1 1/4" x 3 7/8"

I - one - 1 5/8" x 3 7/8"

J - one - 6 1/2" x 1 5/8" L - one - 2 3/8" x 1 1/4"

M – one - 1 5/8" x 1 1/4"

N - one - 6 1/2" x 1 1/4"


#### Tea Cup Fabric:

A - one - 2 3/4" x 3 1/2"

C - two - 7/8" x 1 1/4"


E - one - 7/8" x 2"

K - one - 5" x 1 1/4"



#### Diagram 1

Take your A square of fabric (face up) and lay your two B fabrics down on the bottom two corners. Mark a diagonal line and sew on it. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Open corners.




Sew the two C pieces to each side of D, then add E to the right side to make the handle.

Sew F on to the bottom of handle and then sew handle unit to A/B. Add G to the top, then add H on the right side and I on the left.

### Diagram 2

To make saucer lay K right side up and lay L right side down, perpendicular to K. Do the same with M. Measure 1 1/4" along K and mark a diagonal line. Sew on that line to make the saucer.



Sew J to the top of the block and N to the bottom of the block.
