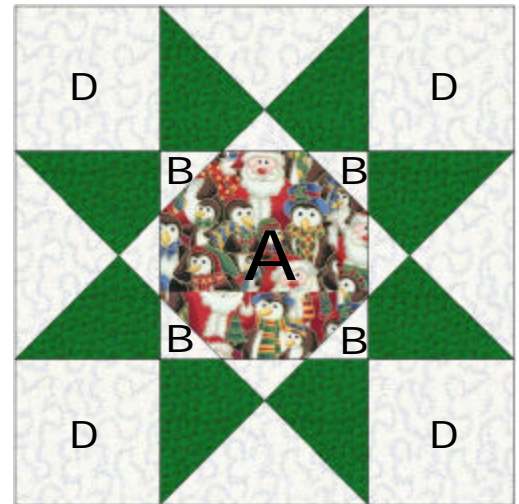


# November 2008 BOM

## Modified Ohio Star

FINISHED BLOCK SIZE 12" X 12"  
(12 1/2" X 12 1/2" Unfinished)

### FABRICS REQUIRED:

Feature Christmas Fabric  
Cream/Off White Print  
Green

### CUT:

1 - 5 1/2" X 5 1/2" square Feature Christmas Fabric (A)

4 - 2" X 2" squares cream (B)  
2 - 6 1/4" x 6 1/4" squares cream  
4 - 4" x 4" squares cream (D)

2 - 6 1/4" x 6 1/4" squares green

### INSTRUCTIONS:

#### 1. Create center snowball block:

Place the 4 cream 2" X 2" squares right sides together on each corner of the featured Christmas print. Draw a diagonal line on each of the squares and sew on the diagonal. (Diagram 2) Trim the excess fabric from the back corners (1/4" from your sewing line). Press. Check to make sure that your block is still 5 1/2" square.

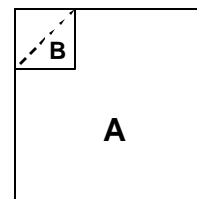

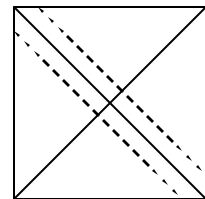

#### 2. Create the Hourglass Blocks:

On the wrong side of the 6 1/4" pieces draw a diagonal line both ways. Place the cream and green 6 1/4" pieces right sides together. Sew a 1/4" seam on both sides of **one** line (Diagram 3). Cut on the center line (Diagram 4). Cut on the remaining drawn line (not sewn) (Diagram 5). Press open creating 4 two-tone triangles. Two with the green on the left and two with the green on the right (Diagram 6). Create four hourglass blocks (Diagram 7).

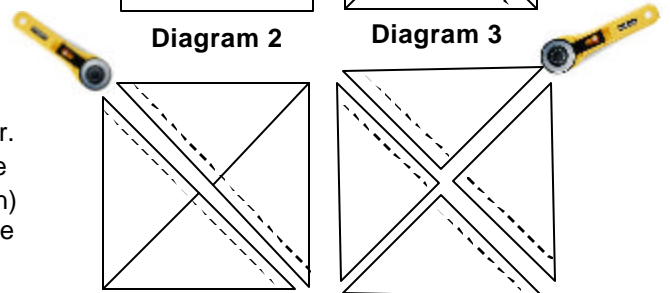

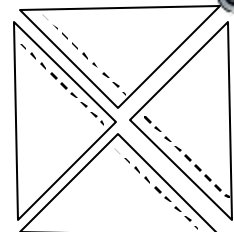

#### 3. Modifying Hour Glass Block:

Trim the hourglass block as show in Diagram 8 - this unit should measure 5 1/2" tall by 4" wide. Place your ruler 1 1/4" away from the center join to get your 4" measurement. Take care to have your green side up when cutting.

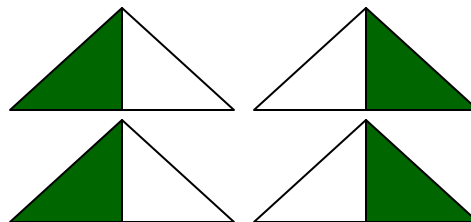

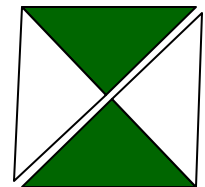

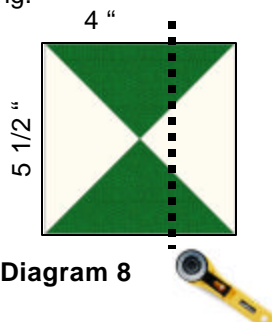
