

## “SNOWMAN” December ’09 BOM

Your challenge for December is create a Snowman block. The block should have a blue background and measure 9 ½” unfinished. You may use the pattern provided and use your favourite appliqué method. Or, you can come up with your own snowman design that could be a pieced or an appliqué design. I would also like to see your creativity come into play decorating your snowman. Beading, found items, stitching, 3 D, whatever appeals to you.

I’ve used a 9 ½” square of blue fabric with snowflake design for my background. I drew a snowman and enlarged it to fit my background fabric. I traced the different parts onto Steam-a-Seam lite. Be sure to reverse your pattern before you trace. Press your pieces onto the wrong side of the fabric. The next step was to start laying out the pieces before securing them. I pressed the layout and fixed it to the background.



Enlarge pattern 300% or larger depending on how you want to fill your background. Have fun decorating your snowman.



I used fabric dyes for the nose and cheeks, the eyes and buttons are black beads.

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
