

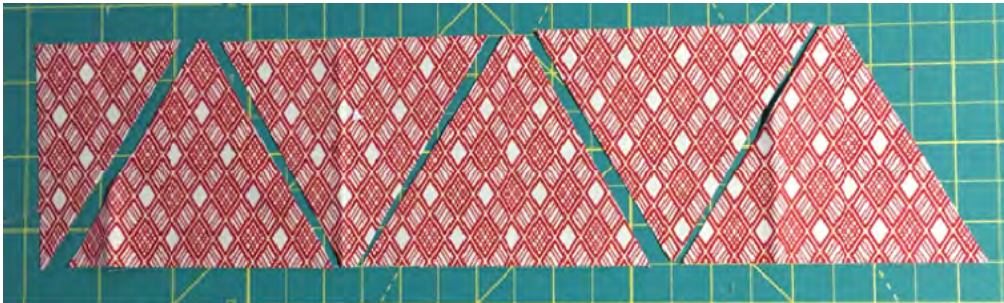
## Block of the Month December 2016

### Six pointed triangle star



Cut 12 red triangles and 24 white, or white with bits of red, triangles. If you want to make the corners from longer strips that is okay.



Using a 60-degree ruler or the 60-degree marking on your cutting mat, cut from a 3" strip:



For reference, the edges of the triangle pieces measure  $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

Lay out your pieces as follows. You will sew the four rows and then join them.

Mine finished at  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " tall and I trimmed to 11" wide. The winner can further square them up or sash the top and bottom.
