

January Block of the Month



We are skipping a seven-pointed star. If that makes too many people sad, we can add it later...

This is an eight-pointed sawtooth star with a fussy cut centre. The centre square will be squares at the table so the blocks will go together. It is brighter than the one pictured.

For the points, choose a bright fabric that goes with it. The background will be white.



CUTTING:

Four corner blocks: cut $2\frac{3}{4}$ " square from white

Eight HST blocks (made four at a time): cut two white and two bright $4\frac{3}{4}$ " squares

Centre block: Fussy cut flower 5" square.



SEWING:

Make the HST blocks as follows: Use one bright and one white square. With right sides together, sew all four outside edge seams. Then cut twice diagonally. Press open and trim to $2\frac{3}{4}$ ". There is a tutorial here:
