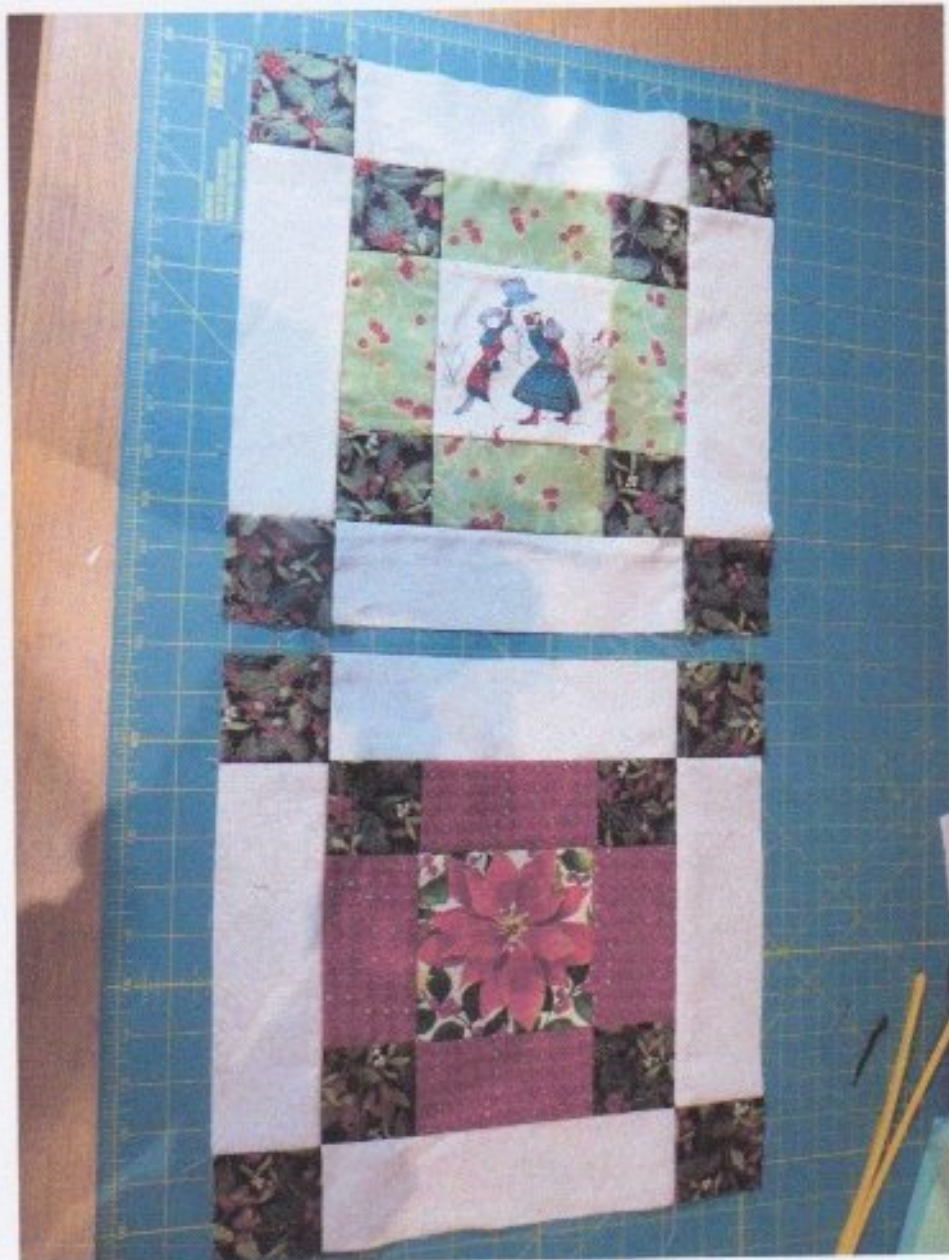


NOVEMBER BLOCK OF THE MONTH

.....preparing for Christmas

A simple block this month. I will bring a number of 4 1/2 in. squares with the snowman scene and the poinsettia from my (rather overflowing!) "fabric library" to the October meeting. If they are all taken, or you cannot attend the meeting, the block will work well with a large-print Christmas item or seasonal scene in the centre. The rest of the patterned fabrics should be Christmas theme if possible or small prints as shown.



Cutting instructions:

Large block A - a $4\frac{1}{2}$ in square

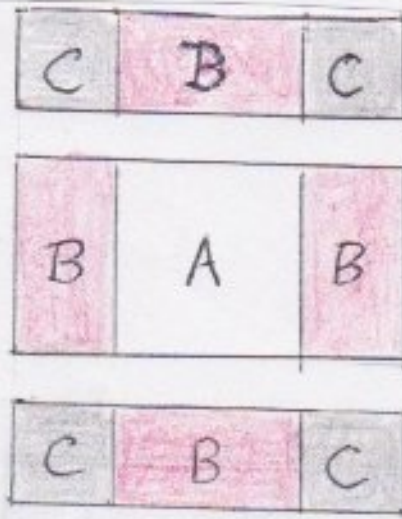
Block B - cut four $2\frac{1}{2}$ in. by $4\frac{1}{2}$ in. from medium red or green lightly patterned fabric

Block C - cut eight $2\frac{1}{2}$ in. squares from black or dark green background small patterned fabric

Block D - cut four $2\frac{1}{2}$ in. by $8\frac{1}{2}$ in. strips from off-white background fabric

Assemble as shown in the diagrams and you will have a $12\frac{1}{2}$ in. block:
