The Adori quilt block is a variation on the log cabin, and is simple to make.



Cutting:

Dark navy background: Two 8 x 2" rectangles
Two 8 x 1 1/4" rectangles
Two 2 3/4" x 2" rectangles
One 2 3/4 x 4" rectangle
Four 2 3/4" squares

White or off white: One 8 x 2" rectangle
One 4 x 3 1/2" rectangle

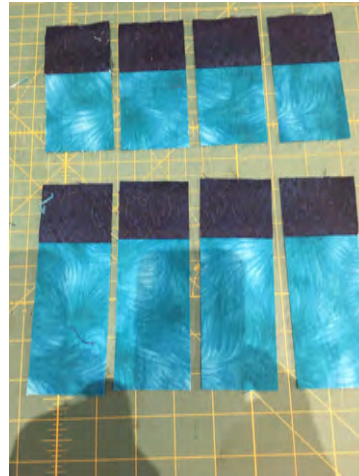
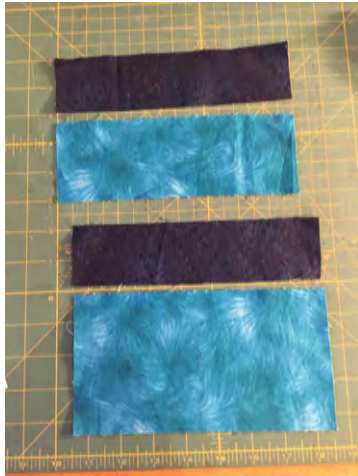
Turquoise: One 8 x 2 3/4" rectangle
One 8 x 4 1/4" rectangle

Yellow: One 8 x 3 1/2" rectangle
One 8 x 2" rectangle

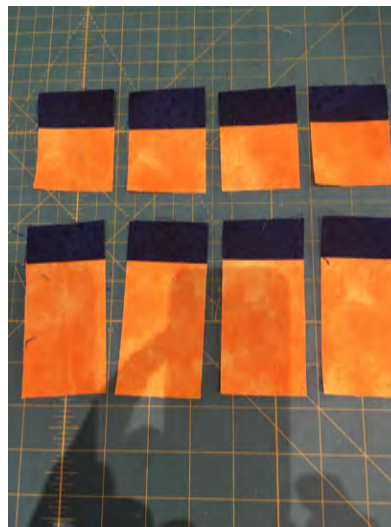
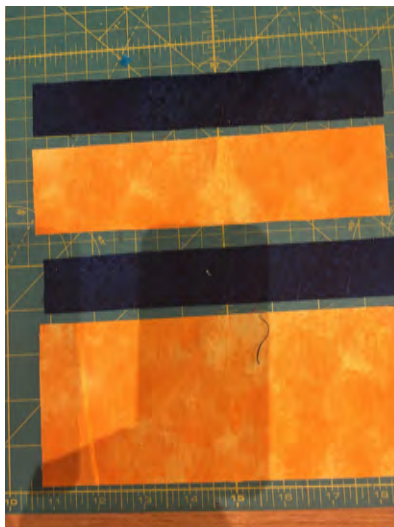
Assembly:

First make the strips for the four log cabin corners.

Sew the 8 x 2" navy rectangle to the 8 x 2 3/4" turquoise rectangle lengthwise, and sew the 8 x 2" navy rectangle to the 8 x 4 1/4" turquoise rectangle lengthwise. Press seams open, then cut each resulting section into four 2" strips as shown.



We repeat this process with the navy and yellow. Sew the 8 x 1 1/4" navy rectangle to the 8 X 3 1/2" yellow rectangle, and the other 8 x 1 1/4" navy piece to the 8 x 2' yellow rectangle as shown, press open and cut into 2" strips.



Next sew the four log cabin blocks for the corners of the square. Arrange the yellow/ navy strips around the four navy $2\frac{3}{4}$ " squares as shown, and sew together starting with the shortest strips.



Then repeat this process with the navy/turquoise strips.



Finally make the centre cross. Sew the $4 \times 2 \frac{3}{4}$ " navy piece to the $4 \times 3 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle lengthwise, press open and cut into two 2" strips. Attach to the log cabins.

Sew one of the $2 \times 2 \frac{3}{4}$ " navy rectangles at each end of the 8×2 " white strip and press. Then sew the whole block together to make a $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " square.
