

## FVQG October 2022 Block of the Month – Up/Down, Left/Right



Block is 10" finished (10 ½" unfinished)

I've used 2 colour families:

**gold** and **red/rust** for the arrows

and a **grey** (neutral) for the background

**You do you**, whatever colours you like for Fall

### CUT

Cut from **Gold** (or your colour choice) fabrics:

5 rectangles – 4 ½ " x 2 ½ "

Cut from **Red/Rust** (or your colour choice) fabrics:

5 rectangles – 4 ½ " x 2 ½ "

Cut from **Grey/or a light Neutral** fabric:

1 rectangle 10 ½ " x 2 ½ "

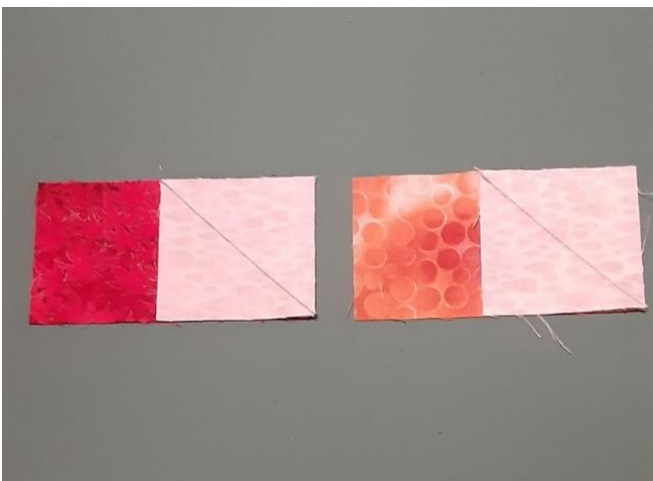
4 squares – 2 ½ " x 2 ½ "



### SEW

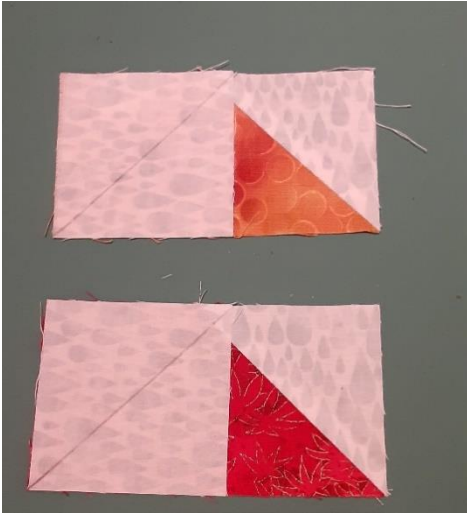
4 Gold (or your colour choice) rectangles, stacking them to create a column, press seams all in one direction

4 Red (or your colour choice) rectangles, stacking them to create a column, press seams all in one direction



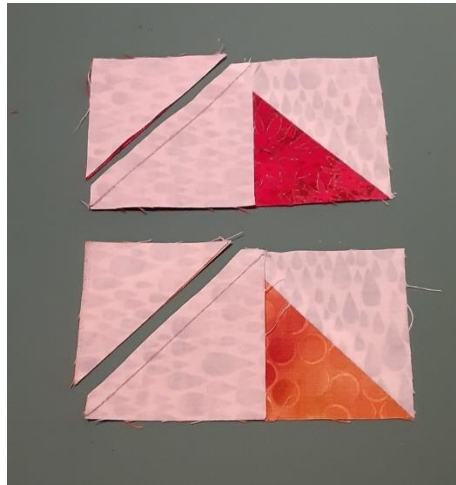
Take the 5<sup>th</sup> Gold (or your colour choice) rectangle and place a Grey/ or light Neutral square on the right side. Do the same for the Red/Rust (or your colour choice) rectangle.

Draw a line on each and sew diagonally from the centre to the right bottom. Cut off the excess fabric on the top right and press towards the outside.



Now place a Grey/or light Neutral square onto the left sides of each rectangle, drawing line from centre to the bottom left.

Again, cut off the excess fabric on the top left and press towards the outside.



Place the **Gold** (or your colour choice) arrow block on top of the **Gold** (or your colour choice) column and sew together. Press the seam in the same direction as the seams in the column. Do the same for the **Red/Rust** (or your colour choice) arrow block and column. Now add the **Grey**/or a light Neutral rectangle in between both of the columns and sew, placing arrows in opposite directions. Press these seams towards the **Grey**/or a light Neutral rectangle
