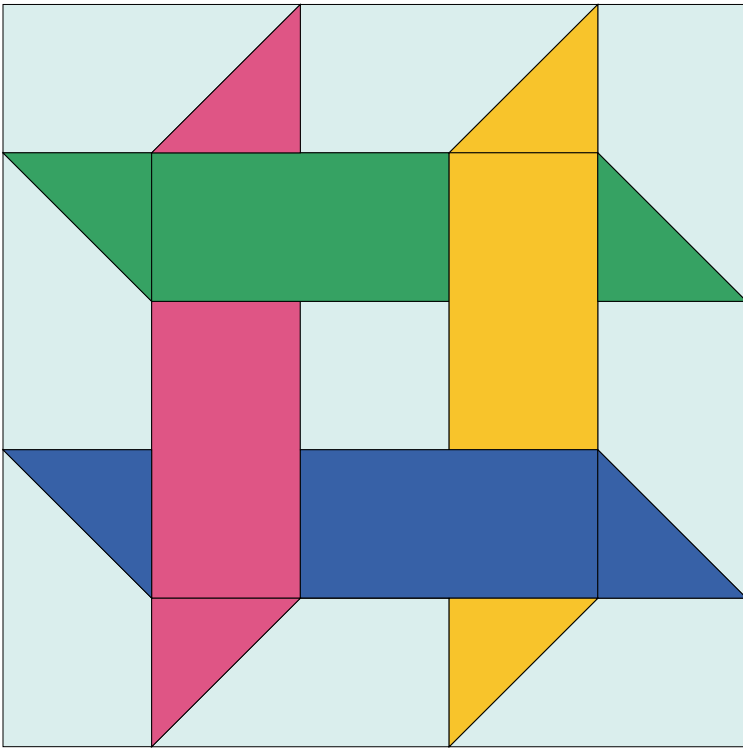


Woven, Pointed Ribbons

10 ½ " (unfinished) - 10" block



From the Coloured Fabrics

Cut 4 rectangles – 2 ½ "x 4 ½ " - 1 of each colour

Cut 2 ½ " squares – 2 from each colour

From the Background Fabric – (light, so it will have good contrast with colours)

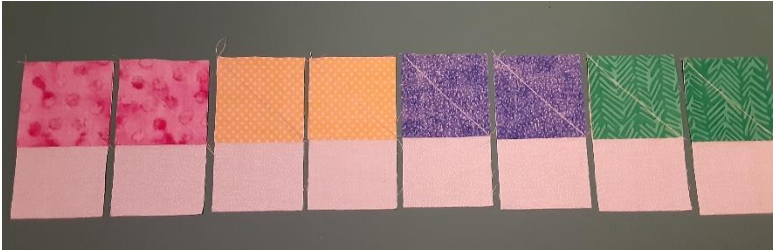
Cut 8 rectangles -- 2 ½ "x 4 ½ " – of background fabric

Cut 1 - 2 ½ " square

Stitch the 4 coloured rectangles around the centre background fabric square, starting with a partial seam on the first seam. Continue adding the rectangles around the centre square. When you come to the last seam finish the partial seam that was the first seam. Now the central part of the block is finished.



Sew the coloured squares to the background rectangles in this way, drawing a diagonal line (as shown) and stitching from top left to bottom right. Cut off the excess fabric and press towards the outside



Stitch the rectangles to each other as shown in the photo.

Another partial seam is required at first. Go around the block and add the rectangle sections and lastly finish the partial seam.
