

Preemie of the Month

A RIBBON RUNS THRU IT

Big simple pieces....what is not to love!

You will need:

Focus print....30 inches

Ribbon fabric.....14 inches

Star.....5 1/2 inches

Binding.....10 inches

Focus print: cut:

2 - 6 1/2 x 26 1/2 strips

2 - 6 1/2 x 20 1/2 strips

2 - 6 1/2 squares

1 - 16 1/2 square

Cut as per diagram, for directional prints they will all be the correct direction and I found it best use of fabric



Optional - center of star as background fabric.... That is what the two 4 1/2 squares in the sketch are...

Stars...you will need the center of star in either the background or star fabric...

2 - 4 1/2 squares

16 - 2 3/4 squares for star points. I like to use oversized points so I don't cut off the "valley". You could also use 2 1/2 inch squares.

Ribbons....from 3 - 4 1/2 WOF strips cut 2 - 20 1/2, 2 - 16 1/2 and 4 6 1/2 strips.



Using stitch and flip, add two points to one end of each ribbon strip.....

Lay out in your design area....especially important if you are working with directional prints



You will assemble the quilt in three "columns/rows....

The center block will have 5 internal rows to sew to make the whole....

The side bars only the 3 pieces....sew them all together and you are done!
