

Patience Corner Block

Amounts given for 36 units made into nine blocks (4 units to a block, finishing 12-1/2" square) for a 36" square top

Fabric 1: .3m or 1/3 yard

Fabric 2: .5m or 5/8 yard

Fabric 3 : .4m or 1/2 yard

Quilt can be "enveloped" or bound with self fabric.

If you chose to bind, an additional .3m of any one of the three colours is needed to cut four 2 3/4" binding strips.

Fabric 1: cut 4 strips 2-1/2" wide by width of fabric ("wof")

Fabric 2: cut 4 strips 4-1/2" wide by width of fabric

Fabric 3: cut 6 strips 2-1/2" wide by width of fabric

1. Strip piece one wof of fabric 1 to one wof of fabric 2, press seams and cut into 4-1/2" lengths.
2. Cut fabric 3 strips into 6-1/2" lengths. Sew one of these fabric 3 strips to the long edge of the units from the first step.
3. Join four of these units to make a fourpatch block using the illustration below for arrangement.

For a different look, fabrics 1 and 3 can be the same.
