

STACKED

Another project for those extra jelly roll strips!

You will need 16 random strips measuring a minimum of 30 inches long.
15 inches of background cut into 6 x 2 1/2 strips
10 inches for binding cut into 4 x 2 1/2 strips
or 25 inches cut into 10 strips if using all the same fabric.

Arrange your strips into a pleasing order and sew together into a strip assembly measuring about 32 1/2 long by width of strips.

Square off one end and cut into 2 units measuring 5 inches and one unit measuring 19 1/2 inches.



Measure the length of your units (approximately 32 1/2), take the average, cut and sew to both sides of the 5 inches wide pieces. Then sew onto both sides of the large center section. You could flip the side sections to give some interest, as shown in bottom picture, but in this case I chose not to since there were some directional fabrics.

Measure your width and cut 2 pieces for top and bottom and add on.
You are done!

If you have lots of strings and/or random width strips filling your space you could sew them together to make a "new fabric" piece measuring (minimum 30inches) by 32 1/2 and use this instead of the jelly roll strips for a fun variation.....you are only limited by your imagination! This would also look great made out of a huge "crumb block".
