

BRICK YARD

Another good scrap quilt, or it could be quite effective using a fabric collection.

The pieces could be cut and assembled either in the vertical or horizontal plane, or even mix it up!

You will need 6 different fabrics plus binding. 7 inches of each

Cut from two 3 1/2 inch strips, 7 - 9 1/2 inches and 2 - 5 inches.



Number your fabrics in a pleasing colour/pattern arrangement from 1 to 6

3	4	5	6	1

Sew into strips using the chart, then sew your strips together and you are done!

Please note I screwed up on the samples and used 7 fabrics because of a brain malfunction on calculating size so that is why it looks a bit different.
