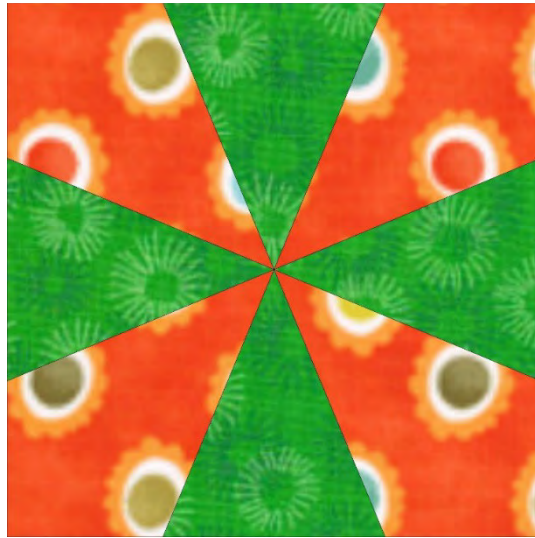


Fraser Valley Quilters' Guild Block of the Month – September 2025

Maltese Cross - Block will finish at 8" (with seam allowance – 8 ½")



Templates OR Paper Piecing to construct the block – your choice.

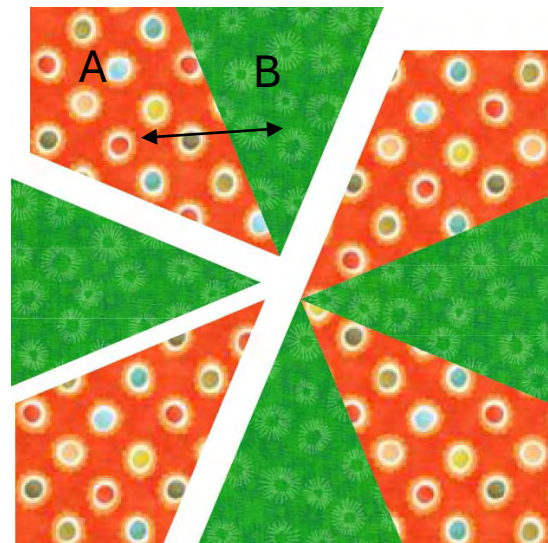
Unit A - whatever wild print that will contrast well with the green **Unit B** - Let's do a medium green

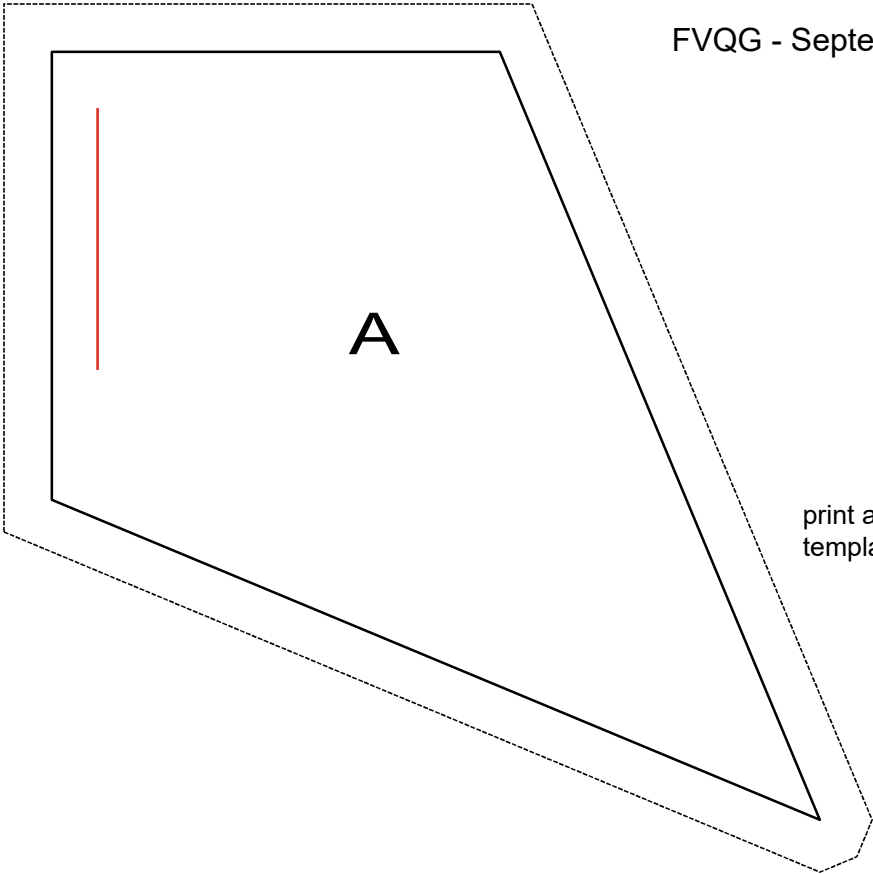
Template technique - Seams are ¼".

For templates, cut 1 unit A and 1 unit B from template plastic or cardboard. The templates below have the ¼" seam allowance included. Trace around Unit A template on the backside of green fabric four times and cut out the triangle shapes. Using a rotary cutter is more accurate, but you could also use scissors. Do the same for Unit B – trace and then cut out 4 of the wild print shapes.

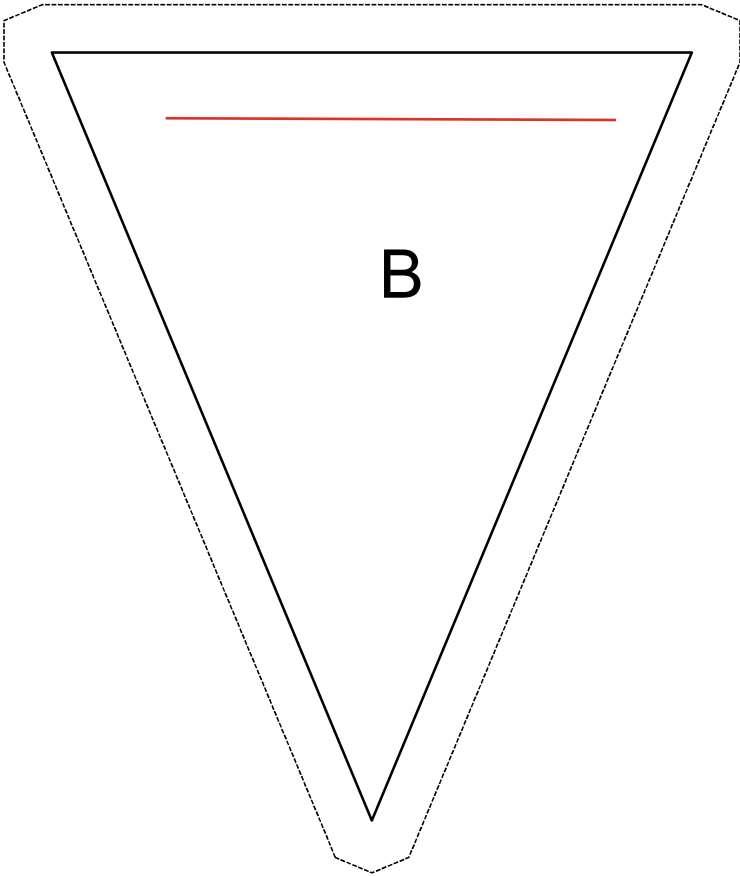
*** If you are doing the paper piecing technique, you can still use the Unit A and B shapes as a guide, just make the shapes a little bit bigger.

Stitch unit A to unit B. Try to make sure that the outside edges are aligned. Stitch another unit A to another unit B. Be careful not to stretch as you stitch (these are slightly biased edges). Stitch the 2 A/B units together to create half of the block. Repeat with the other A and B units to create the second half of the block. Stitch the two halves together.
