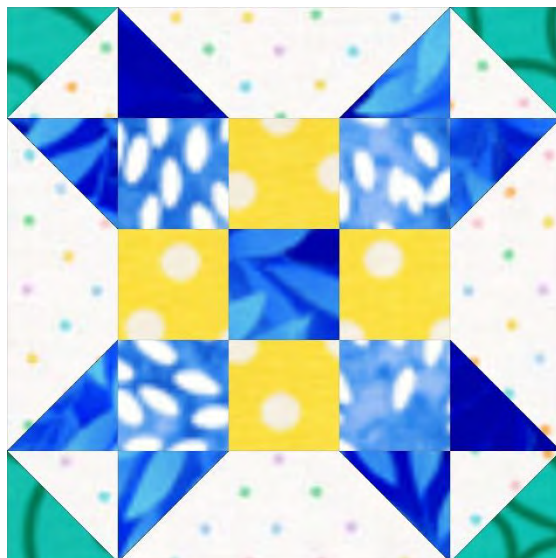


Fraser Valley Quilters' Guild Block of the Month – November 2025

Block will finish at 10" (with seam allowance – 10 ½")



Cut:

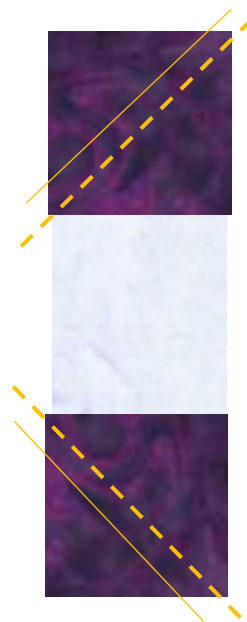
*** Half Square Triangle (HST)

Background fabric:	Dark blue (star tips fabric & centre square)	Medium blue print (in the nine patch unit)	Medium yellow (in the nine patch unit)	Green fabric (HSTs) - outside corners
rectangles (4) 2 ½" x 6 ½"	squares (9) 2 ½" x 2 ½"	squares (4) 2 ½" x 2 ½"	squares (4) 2 ½" x 2 ½"	squares (2) 3 ¼" x 3 ¼" for HSTs
squares (2) 3 ¼" x 3 ¼" for HSTs				

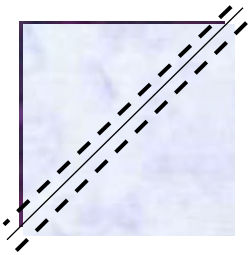
Create 4 of the rectangular units
(for the outer edges of the 9 patch
unit) – see instructions in box.

Place a Dark blue 2 ½" x 2 ½" square
on top of a Background 2 ½" x 6 ½"
rectangle (at the top) with right sides
facing. Draw a diagonal line from the
top right down to the bottom left of
the square. Stich on the line. Press
the triangle up and out towards the
corner. Cut away the extra triangles.
Repeat again on the opposite end,
going from bottom right to top left of
the square. Again, press the triangle
up and out towards the corner. Cut
away the extra triangles.

Repeat this process again to create a
total of 4 units.



Make 4 half square triangles (HSTs) by placing a Background 3 ¼” square on top of a Green 3 ¼” square. Draw a diagonal line across the square. Stich on either side of the line ¼” away from the line. Cut on the middle line. Trim each of these 4 HST units to finish at 2 ½” square.



Construct the block as shown in the diagram.

- Sew the 9-patch unit together for the centre – see diagram for placement of fabrics
- Sew a HST to both ends of a rectangle unit - **Row 1**
- Sew a rectangle unit to left and right of 9-patch unit – **Row 2**
- Sew a HST to both ends of a rectangle unit - **Row 3**
