

MODA LOVE

Re-visiting another oldie but goodie!

The original pattern can be found on Moda's site and numerous tutorials are on the web.

Just Google "Moda love charm quilt" and you will have many options to choose from.

For a 36 inch quilt....You will need:

Background: 16 - 4 1/2 inch squares

18 - 5 inch squares for HST's

"Charm squares" can be as scrappy as you like or a co-ordinated collection.

18 - 5 inch for HST's

12 - more will be trimmed down to 4 1/2

Border strips: 4 WOF cut at 2 1/2 inches,

Either of the background or a print.

Binding: 4 WOF cut at 2 1/2 inches, print of choice.

Pair up the 5 inch backgrounds and charm squares, draw a diagonal line and sew on both sides with a scant 1/4 inch seam. If you are using a directional fabric remember to draw half of the line left to right and the other half in reverse.

Trim your HST's to 4 1/2 inches. Lay your pieces out as per example. Some tutorials suggest making sections and sewing them together or just sew the rows together.

This will give you a 32 inch square. Add your borders, quilt and bind.....and once again you are done!
