

Chevron Heart

Another scrap project, use a co-ordinating collection, colour or make it as scrappy as you like. This would also be fun made up with eye-spy prints. You just want a high contrast with the prints and background so the edges don't "blur".

You will need:

28 - 5 inch squares, of BOTH print and background

2 - 4 1/2 inch squares of background

92 - 2 1/2 squares of prints

Plus binding 4 - 2 1/2 inch WOF strips



Using your 5" squares, make 56 (two at a time) HST's, trim to 4 1/2 inches. If you are using a directional print, remember to draw your lines in both directions so you don't have anyone standing on their head.

From the 2 1/2 inch squares, make

6 - 4 patch units

2 strips with 16 pieces

2 strips with 18 pieces.



Lay your pieces out on your "design floor" following the picture above....once the centre is sewn together, add your 2 short borders on opposite sides and finish up with the last 2 borders.
