

BIG BLOCK #1

This month we are looking at those beautiful fabrics we just can't bear to cut, pillow or other similar small panels.

This uses only 4 fabrics.

The centre is cut to 18 1/2 inches, or if the panel is a bit too small it can be built up with a small border using one of your prints.

The squares (in this case the orange) are cut from 2 WOF - 6 1/2 inches. Cut 8.

The HST's are made from 4 squares of background and print (in this case, the aqua) cut at 7 inches. Draw a line diagonally and sew on both sides, cut on line, press and sliver trim to 6 1/2.

If you don't like to trim the blocks need to be cut at 6 7/8 and sewn very accurately.

4 WOF cut at 3 1/2 from background for outside borders , 4 WOF cut from either print for binding and you are ready to sew!



Arrange pieces as in photo's and sew...side sections, then the top strips, assemble centre, add final borders.....you'll be done in no time at all!
