

## Flap Jack Premie Pattern

Adapted from Fat Quarter Shop's Flapjack pattern. See their website for original pattern and assembly video tutorial. Original quilt measures 60x70 inches

This quilt uses 2 1/2 inch strips and a (cut) 3 1/2 inch border.

You can use a minimum of 5 fabrics or up to a true charm quilt where no 2 pieces are the same.



You will need a total of 15 blocks for the premie size of 36x36

Cutting instructions:

From background fabric: 45... 2 1/2 inch squares (about 3 WOF)  
2.... 3 1/2 x 30 1/2 border strips  
2.... 3 1/2 x 36 1/2 border strips

From assorted prints: 60..... 2 1/2 x 6 1/2 rectangles  
About 12 WOF strips  
(15 rectangles of each if using just 4 prints)



For 45 of the prints, sew a background square onto one end, press towards the print.

Lay out quilt on your design "floor" or on your wall if you are fortunate enough to have one 😊

Don't sweat too much over your arrangement, the main thing is not 2 of the same touching.

NOTE: if only using 4 prints....6 blocks will be mirror image.

Sew your pieces together into blocks, press the vertical seam to the vertical rectangle, the unfinished blocks will measure 6 1/2 x 10 inches.... (The turquoise and darker pink in these examples.)

Sew 5 rows of 3 blocks together, press again to the vertical strip. When joining the rows all your seams should nest together.

Once the centre is assembled sew on the borders and you are done!

This quilt can easily be adapted for Surrey Paed's or Cops for Cancer by adding an extra block to the rows and a few extra rows...or even just by adding an extra border or two!
