

Premie of the Month:

HO HO HO!

Use up those bright Christmas scraps and jelly roll pieces.

You will need a total of 18 of each letter, and a total of 36 blocks.

From background cut 54 squares
2 1/2 inches. (About 3 WOF)

From a 2 1/2 inch print strip. (you
can get both an "H" and an "O"
from a WOF strip)



For the "H" cut: two - 6 1/2 lengths
and one 2 1/2 square (15 1/2 inches total)

For the "O" cut: two 6 1/2 strips and two 2 1/2
squares. (18 inches total)

Arrange your pieces as shown and sew your blocks.

Press "to the dark side"

If you lay out your blocks with the "H" long pieces
vertical and the "O" long pieces horizontal you will
have no seams to match!



Lay out 6 rows of 6 blocks alternating letters. Start the
first row with an "H" and the next with "O"

HO HO HO will read correctly from both 'right side up' and 'upside down' so don't fuss too
much with the direction of your prints.
