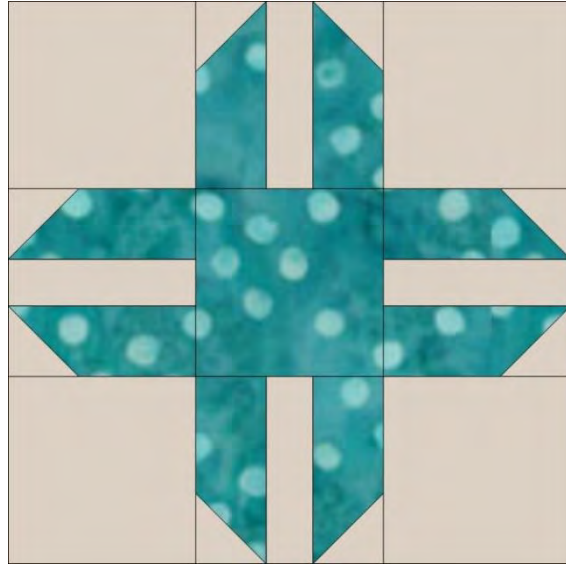
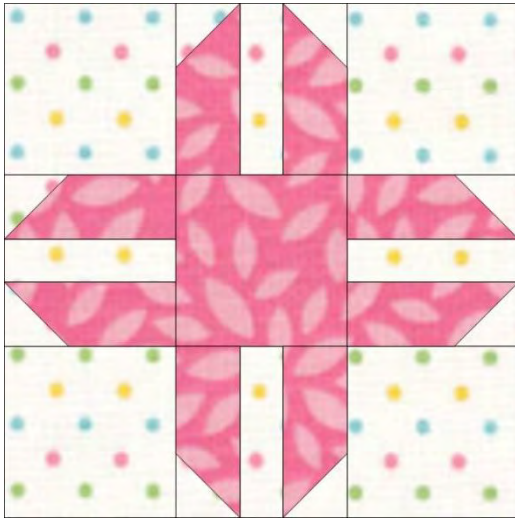


Fraser Valley Quilters' Guild Block of the Month – March 2026

Block will finish at 12" (with seam allowance – 12 1/2")

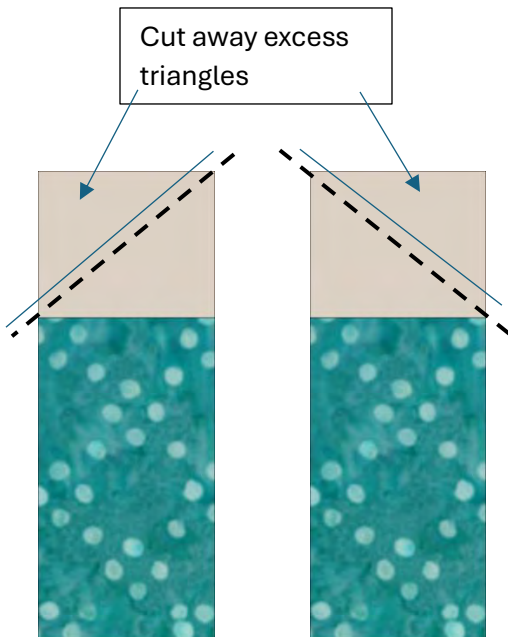
Cut:

Medium or Dark - Pink or Teal Green (solid or small print)	Lighter Background (solid or small print)
4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares (1)	4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares (4)
2" x 4 1/2" rectangles (8)	1 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles (4)
	2" x 2" squares (8)

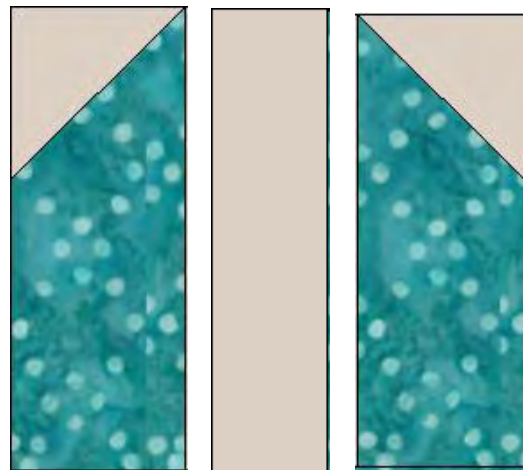
Let's do **Pink OR Teal** for our Block of the Month for March 2026

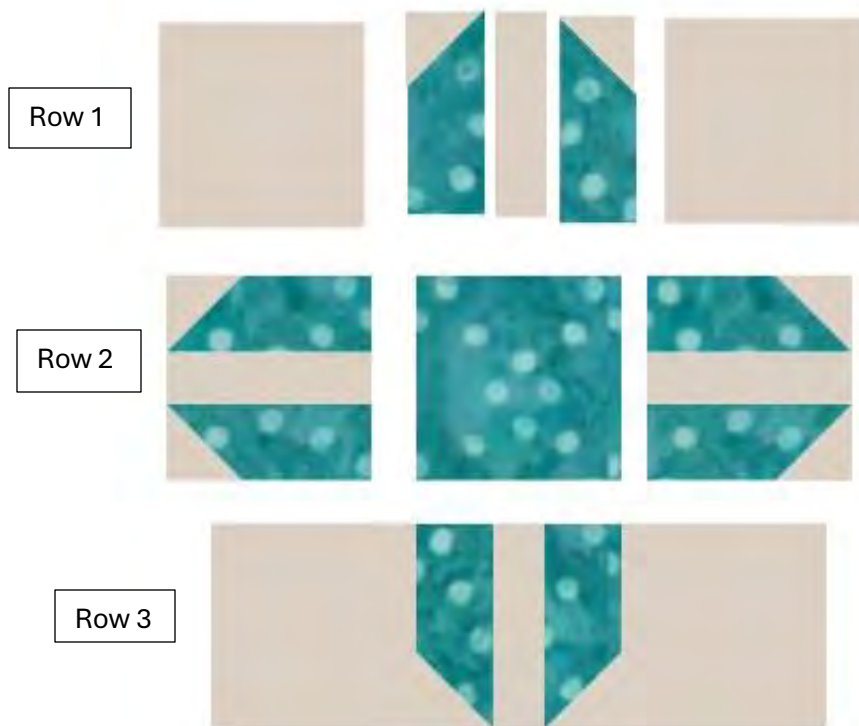
Assemble:

Draw a line diagonally from corner to corner on the wrong side of fabric on all 8 of the small background squares. Lay a square on each of the 8 main fabric rectangles (right sides of fabric facing each other). Sew on the drawn line - 4 with the line going from bottom left to top right and the other 4 going from top left to bottom right (as shown). Once the seam is sewn, cut 1/4" away and remove the extra triangles. Press towards the outside corner.



Stitch a left unit to a background rectangle and then stitch these to the right unit. Repeat 3 times (for a total of 4 of these units).





Place the pieced units pointing outwards, as in the diagram above. Stitch Row 1, then row 2 and then row 3. Stitch them altogether 1 to 2 and then 1-2 to 3.

Measure accurately and then cut accurately. All seams are $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Check your seam allowance to make sure it is accurate. Take your time and this block will come together easily enough.
