

# FRIENDSHIP STAR

Another idea that can be made with as little as 4 fabrics or totally scrappy.....

You will make 8 friendship stars and 8 - 4 patch blocks all to finish at 9 inches.  
It would also look great with some or all of the 4 patches replaced with a single piece of fabric or small panel that finishes to 9 inches. (Cut 9 1/2)

Each star block requires:

From background: 4 - 3 1/2 inches squares  
2 - 4 inch squares for HST's  
From star fabric: 1 - 3 1/2 inch square  
2 - 4 inch squares for HST's

For the 4 patches: 5 inch squares, 64 in total.  
If you are making them all the same you can use a 5 inch WOF, sew together and sub-cut into 5 inch segments. In the second example I used 4 different fabrics and 1 WOF of each.



For the Friendship stars:  
Using the 4 inch squares, draw your diagonal line, sew on both sides, cut in half, press and sliver trim to 3 1/2 inches.  
When laying out your pieces, take care to have all the stars spinning in the same direction, doesn't matter which way, just all the same.



Lay your blocks out and sew together once you have decided your arrangement.

Once again you have made a lovely little quilt!
