

# YELLOW BRICK ROAD

From the pattern by Atkinson Designs.  
Originally modified for us by Donna Mae,  
tweaked by Beth.

You will need 6 fat quarters (or a 7 inch WOF strip)  
Plus binding....  
Even better take 12 fat quarters for variety and  
make two quilts for twins!

I stacked up all 6 of the fat quarters and cut with  
a sharp blade but cut what you are comfortable  
with.

Make your cuts on width of fabric, perpendicular  
to the selvage.

Trim off you selvage and then cut one strip 6 1/2  
inches and two strips 3 1/2 inches.

You will have about 5 inches left over for another project.



Instructions refer to pile of 6 strips.

From the 6 1/2 strip- cut:

2 - 5 inch rectangles

1 - 3 1/2 inch rectangle

REMOVE ONE PIECE- from remainder  
cut - 6 1/2 inch square

From ONE 3 1/2 strip - cut:

1 - 9 1/2 inch rectangle

REMOVE TWO PIECES - from remainder  
cut another 9 1/2 inch rectangle.

From second 3 1/2 inch strip - cut:

2 - 6 1/2 inch rectangles and

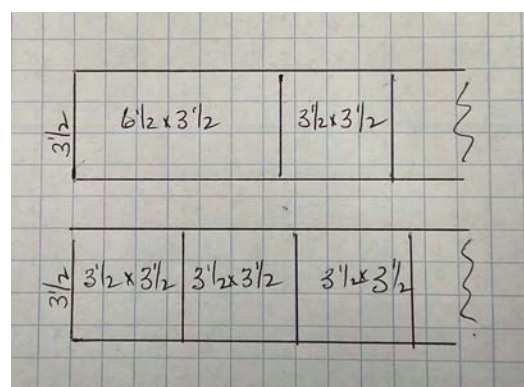
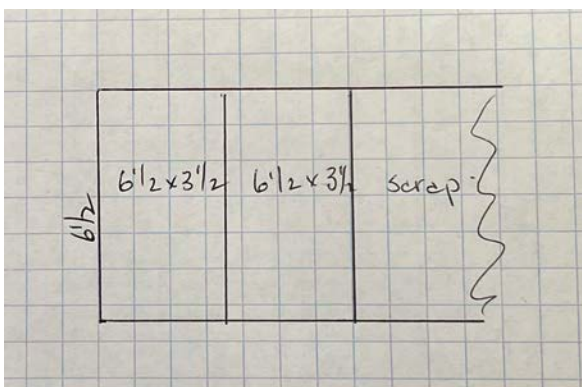
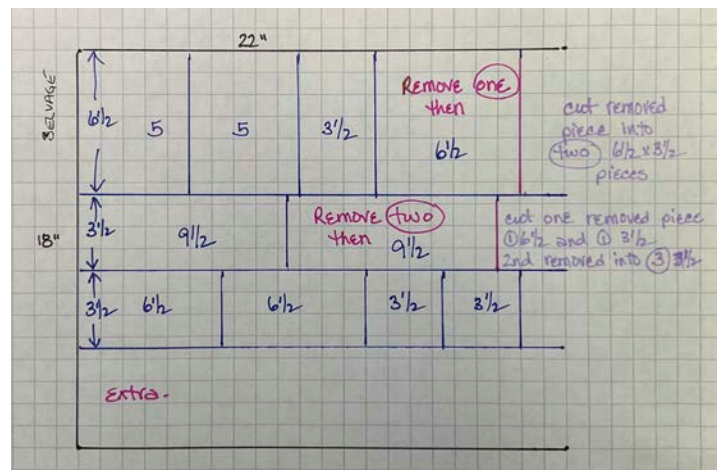
2 - 3 1/2 inch squares

From the removed strips:

The 6 1/2 - cut 2 - 3 1/2 inch rectangles

From ONE 3 1/2 - cut 1 - 6 1/2 inch rectangle and 1 - 3 1/2 inch square

From other strip cut 3 - 3 1/2 inch squares



This will give you all your pieces. You should now have:

5 -  $6\frac{1}{2} \times 6\frac{1}{2}$

12 -  $6\frac{1}{2} \times 5$

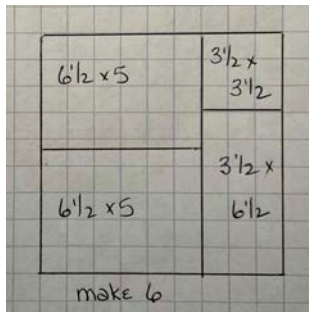
21 -  $6\frac{1}{2} \times 3\frac{1}{2}$

10 -  $9\frac{1}{2} \times 3\frac{1}{2}$

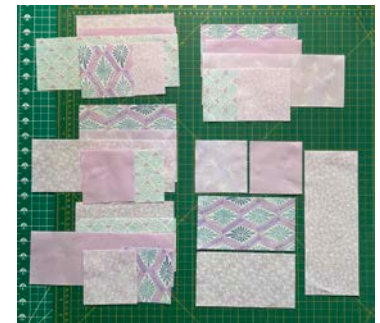
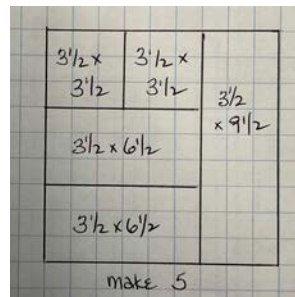
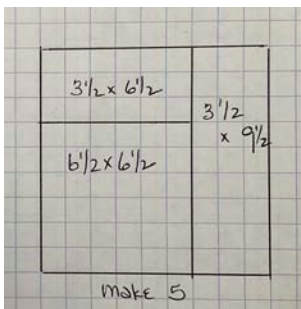
16 -  $3\frac{1}{2} \times 3\frac{1}{2}$

Time to assemble your blocks....

Make 6 -



Make 5 - of each of the two blocks....



I laid out the piles to randomize the fabrics as much as possible before assembling the blocks.

Lay out your blocks, 4 rows of 4 blocks, and another top is done!
